Work Safer, Reduce Injury!

Work Safer is a consultation program that provides workplace health and safety assistance to businesses in Rhode Island. The program helps identify potential health and safety risks within the workplace and assists in developing strategies to safeguard employees. The Work Safer program is voluntary, confidential, and free of charge.

WHO ARE WE?

A federally-funded Rhode Island Department of Health program staffed by OSHA-trained industrial hygienists.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Work Safer Rhode Island will perform a consultation visit at the request of any Rhode Island employer. The free consultation can either be partial or comprehensive. It remains 100% confidential and results in no monetary fines or penalties.

WHAT IS THE OUTCOME?

Addressing workplace health and safety risks can result in increased productivity, fewer lost work hours, and a healthy and engaged work force.

WHAT DOES WORK SAFER DO?

- ✓ **Conduct** a walk-through of your business to help you identify hazards in your workplace.
- ✓ **Provide** a detailed written report of our findings.
- ✓ **Suggest** solutions to potential safety or health hazards.
- ✓ **Assist** in implementing any related OSHA-mandated written programs, standards, and procedures.
- ✓ **Provide** program templates, mitigation strategies, and virtual tools.
- ✓ **Conduct** air and noise sampling upon request.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE WORK SAFER PROGRAM, YOU MUST:



Be a Rhode Island business



Have no more than 250 employees at one site and fewer than 500 nationwide



Be privately owned
