





What You Need to Know About Fall-Winter Vaccines

**Immunizations have been shown to lower risk of severe disease.
Speak to your healthcare provider about the best timing for you.**

Vaccine	Who	What	When
Influenza 	People 6 months and older, adults over 65 may choose to get higher dose	One dose that targets multiple flu strains	Anytime during flu season, September to March
COVID-19 	Recommended for everyone 6 months and older	Targets newer variant	Available Now
RSV 	 Adults over 60	One dose vaccine	Available Now, talk to your healthcare provider
	 Pregnant people at 32-36 weeks	One dose vaccine	Available Now, talk to your healthcare provider
	 Infants under 8 months, high risk children 8-19 months	Monoclonal antibody shot	For babies starting this Fall until Spring, talk to your healthcare provider
