

## **Immunization Requirements For All Children Entering 7<sup>th</sup> Grade**

In accordance with the Rhode Island Department of Health <u>Rules and Regulations</u>

<u>Pertaining to Immunization and Communicable Disease Testing in Preschool, School, Colleges</u>

<u>or Universities [R23-1-IMM]</u>, all students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade are required to have the following immunizations:

- **➤** Three (3) doses of Hepatitis B vaccine
- > One (1) dose of HPV vaccine
- ➤ One (1) dose of Meningococcal conjugate (Meningitis) vaccine
- > Two (2) doses of MMR vaccine (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- > Four (4) doses of Polio vaccine

If the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose was given on/after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, a 4<sup>th</sup> dose is not necessary (total of 3 doses).

- ➤ One (1) dose of Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) vaccine
- > Two (2) doses of Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine received <u>or</u> a statement signed by your child's doctor stating that your child has a history of chickenpox disease.
