

## **Immunization Requirements For All Children Entering Kindergarten**

In accordance with the Rhode Island Department of Health <u>Rules and Regulations</u> <u>Pertaining to Immunization and Communicable Disease Testing in Preschool, School, Colleges or Universities [R23-1-IMM], all students entering kindergarten are required to have the following immunizations:</u>

- Five (5) doses of DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) vaccine If the 4<sup>th</sup> dose was given on/after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, a 5<sup>th</sup> dose is not necessary (total of 4 doses).
- > Three (3) doses of Hepatitis B vaccine
- ➤ Two (2) doses of MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) vaccine
- **➤** Four (4) doses of Polio vaccine

The final dose should be given on/after the 4th birthday.

If the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose was given on/after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, a 4<sup>th</sup> dose is not necessary (total of 3 doses).

> Two (2) doses of Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine *or* a statement signed by your child's doctor stating that your child has a history of chickenpox disease.
