

CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Office of Health Professions Regulations (hereinafter "Department"), upon the application for licensure as a Hair Design Shop filed by **Dante V. Petrarca, D/B/A VIP BARBER SHOP** (hereinafter "Respondent"). Specifically, information obtained by the Department indicated that Respondent violated Chapter 5-10 by operating a salon without a license. A conference was held between the parties on and it was agreed as follows:

1. That the Department shall grant the application for licensure filed by Respondent provided, however, Respondent shall serve a one (1) year period of probation subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Consent Agreement.
2. That Respondent voluntarily accepts the sanction of a Reprimand.
3. That said probationary period shall commence upon the date the Department issues a license to Respondent and will abate for the duration of any period in which the Respondent ceases to operate as a Hair Design Shop.
4. That during the period of probation should Respondent fail to comply with the provisions of Chapter 5-10 and/or the "Rules and Regulations" adopted thereunder, or any of the terms of this Consent Agreement, the Department shall initiate appropriate action with respect to Respondent's licensure status.
5. That this Consent Agreement shall obviate the necessity for a hearing on the matters forming the basis for this Consent Agreement.

6. That at the expiration of the one (1) year period of probation, Respondent may apply to the Department for an unrestricted license as a Hair Design Shop.




