ORDER

Pursuant to Section 5-34-25 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2004 Reenactment, the following constitutes the Findings of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent.

1. Respondent held a practical nurse license on probations in the State of Rhode Island.
2. That Respondent was not compliant with the terms of her probation.
3. That on or about March 1, 2008, Respondent's practical nurse license expired.
4. That on May 17, 2008 the Board of Nursing received a letter from Respondent indicating that she is voluntarily surrendering her license to practice nursing. Attached to the letter was her license card.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby enters the following Order:

1. That Respondent has agreed to voluntarily surrender her practical nurse license.
2. That at the time Respondent seeks reinstatement of her practical nurse license, she shall submit documentation to the Board evidencing that he is capable and competent to engage in the practice of nursing.
3. That this Order shall remain in full force and effect pending further Order of the Board.
