AMENDED CONSENT ORDER

The Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline (hereinafter the "Board") hereby agrees to modify the previously ratified Consent Order for relief from prohibition on methadone prescribing. The Board had received information through the Board of Pharmacy concerning the professional activities of Fredy P. Roland, Jr., M.D. (hereinafter the "Respondent"). The Board had previously restricted the Respondent's practice and ordered him to attend certain Continuing Medical Education programs that were didactic in nature. The Board makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACTS AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent is a physician licensed to practice medicine in Rhode Island under license number MD06717. His primary business address is 333 School Street, Pawtucket, RI 02861. He is a 1983 graduate of the University of Liege, Belgium.
2. The Board restricted Respondent's license to practice medicine and ordered certain remedial education by virtue of a Consent Order ratified on April 11, 2012. Respondent has successfully completed remedial education regarding

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controlled substance prescribing and methadone prescribing since that time and has complied with the prior Order.

3. Respondent's medical charts have been under review consistently from Affiliated Monitors and are found to be much improved and meeting the standards expected of the profession.
4. Respondent's Controlled Substances Registration was previously restored under a separate order but with a restriction regarding methadone prescribing.
5. The Board agrees that Respondent has met the criteria of the prior order and shall be allowed to prescribe methadone in accordance with state and federal statutes and guidelines.

Based on the foregoing, the parties agree to the following orders:

1. Respondent submits to the jurisdiction of the Board.
2. Respondent acknowledges and hereby waives:
 - a. The right to appear personally, by counsel, or both before the Board;
 - b. The right to produce witnesses and evidence on his behalf at a hearing;
 - c. The right to cross examine witnesses;
 - d. The right to have subpoenas issued by the Board;
 - e. The right to further procedural steps except as specifically contained herein;

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- f. Any and all rights of appeal to this Consent Order;
 - g. Any objection to the fact that this Consent Order will be presented to the Board for consideration and review;
 - h. Any objection to the fact that it will become necessary for the full Board to become acquainted with all the relevant information pertinent to this matter in order to review this Consent Order adequately; and
 - i. Any objection to the potential for bias against the Respondent that might occur as a result of presentation of this Consent Order.
3. Acceptance of this Consent Order constitutes an admission by the respondent to the findings of fact made by the Committee.
 4. This Consent Order shall become part of the public record once it has been accepted by all the parties.
 5. The findings and terms of the April 11, 2012, Consent Order shall remain in effect to the extent not inconsistent with this Amended Consent Order.
 6. Respondent's license is no longer restricted and he may prescribe methadone in accordance with state and federal laws and accepted community standards.
 - ~~7. Respondent shall remain on probation for five years from ratification of the previous order of April 11, 2012.~~
 8. Failure to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, once ratified, shall subject Respondent to further disciplinary action.


