CONSENT ORDER

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 23-17.9-1 et seq. and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, the Rhode Island Department of Health (hereinafter "RIDOH"), and the Nursing Assistant Advisory Board (hereinafter "Board") have investigated a complaint charging ALBALIS ALBA (hereinafter "Respondent"), with conduct subject to disciplinary proceedings pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 23-17.9-8. After review and consideration by RIDOH and the Board with respect to the Respondent's conduct, the following are and shall constitute

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is a Nursing Assistant licensed to practice in Rhode Island under Nursing Assistant License NA44580.
- 2. At all times relevant hereto, Respondent was employed as a nursing assistant by Morning Star Home, LLC, 349 Centerville Road, Warwick, RI.
- 3. On or about January 11, 2018, Respondent signed a statement in which she admitted that she utilized an ATM card that belonged to a patient in her care, and, without the patient's knowledge or consent, made withdrawals from the patient's bank account in the amount of \$1,070.00.
- 4. The conduct described in paragraph 3 constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to RIGL 23-17.9-8(1) and (5), and § 6.1(a) and (e) of the Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Rhode Island Certificates of Registration for Nursing Assistants, Medication Aides and the Approval of Nursing Assistant and Medication Aide Training Programs.
- 5. That the Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of RIDOH.

- 6. Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by the Respondent and RIDOH.
- 7. That Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
 - a. The right to an administrative hearing on this matter;
 - b. The right to represent himself or be represented by an attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;
 - c. The right to produce testimony, witnesses, and evidence on Respondent's behalf; at a hearing; and
 - d. Any and all rights of appeal.

ACCORDINGLY, AND BASED ON THE FOREGOING

RIDOH and the Respondent hereby agree to the following disposition of this complaint:

1. Respondent voluntarily surrenders her Nursing Assistant license.

2. This Consent Order shall become a public record.
