**CONSENT ORDER**

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 23-17.9-1 *et seq.* and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, the Rhode Island Department of Health (hereinafter "RIDOH"), and the Nursing Assistant Advisory Board (hereinafter "Board") have investigated a complaint charging KHALIL MULVEY, NA44403 (hereinafter "Respondent"), with conduct subject to disciplinary proceedings pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 23-17.9-8. After review and consideration by RIDOH and the Board with respect to the Respondent's conduct, the following are and shall constitute

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent is a Nursing Assistant licensed to practice in Rhode Island under Nursing Assistant License NA44403.
2. At all times relevant hereto, Respondent was employed by Tockwotton on the Waterfront.
3. On or about November 21, 2017, Respondent admits that he asked another Nursing Assistant to secure a specific medication for him from a patient, that he and the other Nursing Assistant entered a patient's room, that the other Nursing Assistant removed medication from the patient's medication box, and gave said medication to the Respondent who did ingest said medication.
4. That the conduct described in paragraph three of this Consent Order constitutes conduct subject to disciplinary proceedings pursuant to R. I. Gen. Laws §23-17.9-8 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder.
5. That the Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of RIDOH.

6. Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by the Respondent and RIDOH.
7. That Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
  - a. The right to an administrative hearing on this matter;
  - b. The right to represent himself or be represented by an attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;
  - c. The right to produce testimony, witnesses, and evidence on Respondent's behalf; at a hearing; and
  - d. Any and all rights of appeal.

ACCORDINGLY, AND BASED ON THE FOREGOING

RIDOH and the Respondent hereby agree to the following disposition of this complaint:

1. Respondent is hereby issued the sanction of a Reprimand on his Nursing Assistant license, NA44403.
2. Respondent will participate in 3 hours of continuing education classes in medication safety and will provide the Board with proof of completion on or before July 15, 2018. If proof of completion is not provided to the Board on or before July 15, 2018, additional disciplinary action may be taken against Respondent's license.
3. This Consent Order shall become a public record.
