That on or about the time frame of October of 2010 to November of 2010, the Respondent, while employed at CVS/Pharmacy #4796 located at 960 Broad Street, Providence, RI, admitted to diverting the prescription substance, Cozaar and the schedule III controlled substance, Hydrocodone/APAP.

Based on the foregoing, the Department hereby enters the following:

1. That this Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding.
2. That the Department is hereby revoking Respondent's license as a Pharmacy Technician I.
