
**ORDER**

This matter is before the Department of Health (hereinafter "Department") and the Board of Pharmacy upon allegations of unprofessional conduct relating to the diversion of controlled substances. That while employed at Rite Aid #10256 located at 655 Warren Avenue, East Providence, RI, Respondent admitted to the diversion of controlled substances. That on or about the timeframe of September 2011 to October of 2011, Respondent admitted to the diversion of Hydrocodone/APAP 10mg/500mg, Hydrocodone/APAP 7.5mg/750mg, and Alprazolam 2mg.

Based on the foregoing, the Department hereby enters the following:

1. That this Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding.
2. That the Department is hereby revoking Respondent's license as a Pharmacy Technician I.
