
ORDER

This matter is before the Department of Health and the Board of Pharmacy (hereinafter "Department") upon allegations of unprofessional conduct relating to the diversion of controlled substances. That while employed at Rite Aid #10219 located at 719 Tiogue Avenue, Coventry, RI Respondent was responsible for the diversion of controlled substances. That on or about the timeframe of November 2010 to May of 2011, Respondent admitted to the diversion of Hydrocodone/APAP 10mg/325mg, a schedule III controlled substance pursuant to *R.I. Gen Laws 21-28-2.08* and Alprazolam 2mg, a schedule IV controlled substance pursuant to *R.I. Gen Laws 21-28-2.08*.

Based on the foregoing, the Department hereby enters the following:

1. That this Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding.
2. That the Department is hereby revoking Respondent's license as a Pharmacy Technician I.
