SUMMARY SUSPENSION


Kaitlin Martha Rychlec (hereinafter "Respondent") is licensed as a Limited Pharmacist (Intern) pursuant to *R.I. Gen. Laws 5-19.1-15* and holds license number PHL03736.

On or about November 23, 2012, while employed as a Limited Pharmacist (Intern) at Rite Aid Pharmacy #10243 located at 170 Granite Street, Westerly, RI, Respondent admitted to the diversion of controlled substances. Respondent admitted to the diversion of Oxycodone 15mg, a schedule II controlled substance pursuant to R.I. Gen Laws 21-28-2.08. Respondent admitted to forging a prescription for Oxycodone 15mg using a prescription which had previously been dispensed. In addition, Respondent admitted to the diversion of Buprenorphine 2mg, a schedule III controlled substance pursuant to R.I. Gen Laws 21-28-2.08.

Based upon the foregoing, the Director of Health has determined that the continuation of the license of Respondent as a Limited Pharmacist (Intern) constitutes an imminent threat to the health, welfare and safety of the public. Accordingly, the Limited Pharmacist (Intern) license of Respondent is hereby suspended forthwith. Said suspension shall continue indefinitely pending further Order of the Department of Health.

The Respondent may request a hearing in writing by December 7, 2012.
