SUMMARY SUSPENSION


Shawn Tingley (hereinafter "Respondent") is licensed as a Limited Pharmacist (Intern) pursuant to *R.I. Gen. Laws 5-19.1-15* and holds license number PHL04134.

From on or about September 2011 through July 2012, while employed as a Limited Pharmacist (Intern) at CVS/Pharmacy #0311 located at 507 Main Street, East Greenwich, RI, Respondent admitted to the diversion of controlled substances. Respondent admitted to the diversion of various strengths of the schedule III controlled substances, Hydrocodone/APAP ("Vicodin") and Buprenorphine/Naloxone ("Suboxone") in addition to various strengths of the schedule IV controlled substance, Alprazolam ("Xanax").

Based upon the foregoing, the Director of Health has determined that the continuation of the license of Shawn Tingley as a Limited Pharmacist (Intern) constitutes an imminent threat to the health, welfare and safety of the public. Accordingly, the Limited Pharmacist (Intern) license of Shawn Tingley is hereby suspended forthwith. Said suspension shall continue indefinitely pending further Order of the Department of Health.

The Respondent may request a hearing in writing by August 24, 2012. Pursuant to RIGL 42-35-14(c).
