**ORDER**

Pursuant to Section 5-34-24 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2008 Reenactment, a complaint was filed with the Board of Nurse Registration and Nursing Education (hereinafter referred to as "Board") charging Amy Butler-Bourgoin, RN, Respondent, with violation of Chapter 5-34 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2008 Reenactment.

After consideration by the Investigating Subcommittee of the Board, the following constitutes the Findings of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent.

1. That on September 3, 2008 it was reported by her treatment provider that the Respondent was non compliant with her Diversion Contract, missed scheduled treatment appointments, sounded frantic and disoriented when communicating with her treatment providers and tested positive for pseudo/ephedrine on her toxicology screen August 8, 2008.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby enters the following Order:

That the conduct described in paragraph one (1) above constitutes unprofessional conduct as defined in Sections 5-34-24 (4) in that the Respondent's actions fail to conform to the standards established by the nursing profession.


1. That the registered nurse license issued to the Respondent is hereby voluntarily surrendered effective September 4, 2008.

2. That at the time Respondent seeks reinstatement of her registered nurse license, she shall submit documentation to the Board evidencing that she is capable and competent to engage in the practice of nursing.
3. That this Order shall remain in full force and effect pending further Order of the Board.

The Respondent may request a hearing on this matter, which will be scheduled within ten (10) days, if so requested.
