
SUMMARY SUSPENSION

Joseph A. Iannuccilli (hereinafter "Respondent") is licensed as a registered pharmacist pursuant to *R.I. Gen. Laws 5-19.1-14* and holds license number RPH04184.

From on or about the timeframe of 2006 through 2012, Respondent obtained over six thousand (6,000) dosage units of various Hydrocodone products through the utterance of false prescriptions in violation of *R.I. Gen Laws 21-28-4.05*. Based upon the foregoing, the Director of Health has determined that the continuation of the license of Joseph A. Iannuccilli as a registered pharmacist constitutes an imminent threat to the health, welfare and safety of the public. Accordingly, the registered pharmacist license of Joseph Iannuccilli is hereby suspended forthwith. Said suspension shall continue indefinitely pending further Order of the Department of Health.

The Respondent may request a hearing in writing within ten (10) days if desired.
