RE: LETTER OF REPRIMAND

Dear Ms. Sidel:

At its meeting held 21 October 1992, the Rhode Island Board of Pharmacy reviewed the complaint filed with the Division of Drug Control by the Division of Facilities Regulation which outlined an allegation of unprofessional conduct on your part relating to a survey conducted at Maynard Nursing Home, and a deficiency pertaining to expired medications in the Emergency Drug Box.

It is hereby the decision of the Board of Pharmacy to issue you this Letter of Reprimand, in that you admitted in a statement that the incident was a mistake in judgment on your part. Therefore, the board concluded that your actions constituted unprofessional practice which warranted the issuance of this written reprimand.

If you are aggrieved by this decision, you may appeal this action by written notification to this office within ten (10) days of receipt of this letter.
