


## The Year in Review

In accordance with the Emergency Medical Services Transportation Act, Rhode Island General Law §23-4.1-3(e), the Rhode Island Department of Health's (RIDOH's) Center for Emergency Medical Services (CEMS) releases its 2015 annual report to Governor Gina M. Raimondo and the leadership of the General Assembly.

During the calendar year 2015, under the recommendation of the Director of Health, the office was renamed and was placed within the Division of Emergency Preparedness, Response, Infectious Diseases and Emergency Medical Services (PRIDEMS). The core functions of CEMS did not change; however, the opportunity for collaboration with other centers in the division proved to be beneficial.

It is important to note that RIDOH and CEMS work in close cooperation with the Ambulance Service Coordinating Advisory Board (RIGL §23-4.1-2) regarding many of CEMS' functions, and their assistance and guidance is invaluable.

In August 2015, the Chief of CEMS was appointed to serve on the Governor's Overdose Prevention and Intervention Task Force. CEMS provided data from the Rhode Island EMS Information System to the Task Force and provided a monthly update regarding the number of naloxone (Narcan®) administrations provided by EMS professionals throughout the state.



RIDOH worked to phase out the administration of its in-house Emergency Medical Technician-Cardiac (EMT-C) cognitive examination and replace it with a requirement for certification from the National

Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) to mirror the licensing process for Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs) and Paramedics in the state. Discussions continued with the Ambulance Service Coordinating Advisory Board and key stakeholders throughout the state, including the Rhode Island Association of Fire Chiefs, the Rhode Island State Association of Firefighters, and local municipalities in order to come to consensus on a united licensing process. The primary benefit of using an accredited examination is that it is legally defensible and is constructed by subject matter experts, in conjunction with professional testing. Other advantages include a streamlined licensing process, enhanced portability for EMS practitioners, and a larger applicant pool for EMS agencies in Rhode Island.

Significant progress was made to migrate Rhode Island from the National EMS Information System (NEMSIS) v2.2.1 dataset to the v3.4 standard, which will be fully integrated by the end of 2016. Rhode Island first implemented a statewide requirement for electronic, patient-care reporting in 2014, and all licensed EMS agencies are currently compliant with this mandate. The NEMSIS v3.4 aligns EMS data with hospital data by utilizing the 10th edition of the International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems (ICD-10) coding.

Mobile Integrated Healthcare/Community Paramedicine was a concept that had an increased presence nationally and its implementation in Rhode Island continued to be explored. Several municipalities and ambulance services have expressed interest in these programs, which are designed to enhance patient care in the communities by expanding the role, but not scope of practice, of EMS practitioners. By partnering with primary care physicians and hospitals, EMS practitioners can play a role in reducing the number of unnecessary hospitalizations. Pilot projects are expected to start in 2016.

CEMS had the opportunity to work with many internal and external partners to shape healthcare policy and improve delivery of care to all Rhode Islanders. CEMS staff members are active participants on the Governor's Overdose Prevention and Intervention Task Force, the Stroke Task Force, the HeartSafe Communities project, the Drug Overdose Prevention and Rescue Coalition, and the Child Death Review Team. Externally, the Chief of CEMS was appointed to the E-911 Advisory Commission by the Director of Health. CEMS staff members regularly attended meetings of the Traffic Records Coordinating Committee of the Rhode Island Department of Transportation, as CEMS provides data for the Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS).

On the national level, CEMS staff were active members of the National Association of State EMS Officials (NASEMSO), and served on the group's Domestic Preparedness and Mobile Integrated Health committees. Additionally, in 2015, Carolina Roberts-Santana, the EMS for Children Program Director,

served as the Pediatric Emergency Care Council Chair-Elect for NASEMSO and the New England Regional Lead.

National EMS Week was celebrated in May 2015 with the second annual EMS Awards Ceremony, where EMS personnel were honored for their dedicated service. Honorees, who were nominated by their peers and selected by CEMS staff, were:

- Michael O'Brien, Portsmouth Fire Department; EMS Coordinator of the Year (See Figure 1)
- James Teevan, Ashaway Ambulance Association; Volunteer ALS EMT of the Year
- Eliza Chase, Jamestown Fire Department; Volunteer BLS EMT of the Year
- Ernest Robin, North Kingstown Fire Department; Career EMT of the Year
- Fred Vohr, MD, Rhode Island Disaster Medical Assistance Team; EMS Medical Director of the Year
- Special recognition awards were also presented to Chief Michael DeMello of South Kingstown EMS and Deputy Chief Jason Umbenhauer of the Warwick Fire Department for their outstanding contributions to EMS education and data management, respectively.





# Ambulance inspections and Equipment for Vehicles

CEMS maintained a minimum list of equipment that is required to be carried by each licensed ambulance in the *Rhode Island Emergency Medical Services Ambulance and Ambulance Service Inspection & Licensing Manual*, based upon the vehicle class (transporting or non-transporting, basic life support or advanced life support). Advanced life support vehicles include those vehicles that are staffed by EMT-Cardiacs and Paramedics. There is no licensing designation differentiating between the two levels of advanced life support; however, a service may choose to stock paramedic-level equipment and medications if they are staffed by the appropriate personnel.



### Ambulance Inspections

The Division of Emergency Medical Services routinely inspects ambulances for compliance with the minimum equipment list and general state of repair. Certain items are considered essential equipment and, if missing, the ambulance is determined to have a critical (“immediate”) deficiency.

### Key Points

- RIDOH's 2014 goal is for fewer than 5.0 percent of ambulances to have immediate deficiencies. In 2012, 38.7 percent were found to have at least one immediate deficiency; that rate increased to 56.0 percent in 2013.
- The Division aims to reduce the number of immediate deficiencies per inspection, as well as other deficiencies, through strong enforcement. RIDOH is currently developing a plan to improve the inspection process and reduce the number of deficiencies.

## EMS Education

The Rhode Island Curricula and Standards for EMS Educational Programs were revised in 2015. Highlights of the revisions included using the Advanced EMT National EMS Education Standards (Administration, 2016) as the foundation for EMT-Cardiac education and employing the NREMT Advanced EMT practical skills examination as an independent evaluation.

CEMS developed a state-level accreditation process in 2014 to better oversee educational programs operating in the state. CMS continued to develop this process in 2015. Application review and several site visits were conducted by CEMS staff to verify that educational institutions met the criteria set forth in the Rhode Island EMS Educational Programs Accreditation Standards and Guidelines. As of December 31, 2015, there were 11 educational institutions authorized to conduct initial training courses in Rhode Island.

All paramedic education programs are required to be accredited by, or hold a letter of review from, the Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for the EMS Professions (CoAEMSP). This is also a requirement for a paramedic candidate to be eligible to take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) examinations. As of December 31, 2015, there is one educational program fully accredited by CoAEMSP and two programs hold a letter of review.

Appendix A contains the 2015 Rhode Island state report from the NREMT. As of December 31, 2015, the Training Coordinator position remained vacant; however, CEMS will continue to investigate means to improve pass rates in conjunction with the Educational Standards committee of the Ambulance Service Coordinating Advisory Board.

## Data Management


CEMS transitioned to a National EMS Information System (NEMSIS) compliant and fully electronic dataset, utilizing ImageTrend as its vendor. All licensed EMS agencies provided only electronic, Patient-care reports, which were uploaded to the state data repository on a regular basis. CEMS worked with the Data Management Committee of the Ambulance Service Coordinating Advisory Board (ASAB) for the migration to the most current version of NEMSIS (3.4).

Rhode Island provided quarterly de-identified data uploads to NEMSIS, which offers a web portal for states to access the data in a dashboard format. Additionally, Rhode Island participated in a NEMSIS pilot project

in which all EMS agencies in the state received a quarterly report card about the quality of the data they submitted compared to other agencies in the state.

CEMS provided data to a wide array of partners, including NEMSIS, the Governor’s Overdose Prevention and Intervention Task Force, the Rhode Island Department of Transportation, and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). Internally, CEMS reported monthly to the drug overdose dashboard and provided data to the Center of the Office of State Medical Examiners and the Violence and Injury Prevention Program.

## Complaint Investigation

One responsibility of CEMS is to investigate complaints, which may result in disciplinary action. In 2015, EMS investigated 44 complaints involving licensed EMS practitioners, EMS services, ambulances or, in some instances, a combination of the three.

The nature of complaints received range from criminal arrest, such as any felony and misdemeanor counts, violations of the *Rules and Regulations Relating to Emergency Medical Services [R23-4.1EMS]* or *RI Prehospital Care Protocols and Standing Orders* (medication errors, failing to transport to the proper emergency facility, misapplying protocols, etc.), to patient-care issues.

Complaints originated from the general public, patients and/or their families, other licensed healthcare providers, CEMS, or the Office of the State Medical Examiners. CEMS investigated each complaint filed and complaints were accepted anonymously. Any disciplinary actions taken against an EMS practitioner, an EMS vehicle, or an EMS service agency as a result of a complaint were posted on RIDOH's [disciplinary actions website](#).

## Collaboration with Other Department of Health programs

CEMS supports the overall mission of RIDOH by working in collaboration with other centers and programs within RIDOH and has forged many solid working relationships.

CEMS serves as a human resource pool for the RIDOH's Center of Emergency Preparedness and Response (CEPR) during departmental incident and emergency responses, and members of the CEMS staff have completed training, including forklift operator training and Incident Command System operations training. Staff members also provided first aid to visitors or staff who become ill or injured and conduct CPR and first aid training.

# Emergency Medical Services for Children

## Program Background

The Emergency Medical Services for Children Program (EMSC) is designed to reduce child and youth mortality and morbidity resulting from severe illness or trauma and is made possible through a U.S. Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) grant. The program aims to:

1. Develop and implement new statewide EMS treatment protocols that emphasize pediatric emergency care, along with supporting EMT education and training programs;
2. Develop programs for parents and communities, which:
  - a. Identify and reduce barriers to emergency care for children;
  - b. Provide information relating to health promotion and injury prevention; and
  - c. Focus on recognition of emergencies, and improving access to and appropriate use of the local EMS systems; and
3. Provide periodic case reviews and follow-up to EMS personnel in pediatric cases.

EMSC is a national initiative that was established in 1985 to reduce childhood death and disability due to severe illness or injury. It has successfully raised awareness among healthcare professionals, EMS and trauma system planners, and the general public that children respond differently – physically, emotionally, and psychologically – to illness or injury than do adults.

In Rhode Island, EMSC has had numerous initiatives in the last 10 years; however, a consistent goal has been the development of pre-hospital and acute-care provider training. EMSC has been involved in establishing EMS guidelines and protocols, equipment lists, and other clinical care resources.

## EMSC in 2015

The EMSC performance measures set goals for states that will help develop more consistency within the EMS and trauma system of care for children across the nation. Rhode Island's EMSC program worked to ensure that all emergency departments are trained and prepared to care for children through the implementation of national quality improvement initiatives. For example, children present unique medical challenges due to differences in anatomy and require specialized assessment and treatment equipment. A heightened focus is placed on regionalized care systems that share resources and improve access to healthcare services for children in tribal, territorial, and rural areas of the United States. In addition, EMSC's funding of multicenter pediatric emergency research in both the prehospital and acute-care settings is expected to reveal new knowledge to guide the future advances in pediatric emergency care.

The new EMSC performance measures were released in 2015 and, as of December 31, 2015, were undergoing final revision. The measures focused on ensuring that EMS practitioners have the adequate resources to serve children and can adequately use the resources. Practitioners were urged to add a pediatric care coordinator to each EMS agency, assuring NEMSIS compliance, and required the documentation of the use of pediatric equipment to enhance education. In 2017, a survey will measure baseline data for the new performance measures and implementation is expected for March 2018.

### Performance Measures

In order to measure the effectiveness of federal grant programs, the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) requires grantees to report on specific performance measures related to their grant-funded activities. The measures are part of the Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) of 1993. The purpose of a performance measure is to document activities and accomplishments of the program in improving and delivering services.







### Course Completion - First Attempt Pass Rates\*




### Course Completion - Cumulative Third Attempt Pass Rates\*

### National Rank


#### Course Completion First Time Pass Rates










