

Rhode Island Controlled Substance Listing January 2024

According to Rhode Island General Law, the Director of the Rhode Island Department of Health (RIDOH) recognizes the current version of <u>Title 21 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR)</u> as the most updated list of controlled substances in Rhode Island.

In addition, the Director of RIDOH has included the following items in the <u>Rhode Island Controlled Substance</u> <u>Act</u> and are considered controlled substances in the State of Rhode Island.

Schedule I

- Mitragynine or hydroxymitragynine (Kratom)
- Trans-3-4-dichloro-N-[2-(diethylamino)cyclohexyl]-N-methyl-benzamide (U-49900-fentanyl analog)
- 4-HO-MET (4-hydroxy-N-methyl-N-ethyltryptamine, metocin, or methylcybin)
- N-methyl norfentanyl
- 3-methoxy PCP

- Butalbital/acetaminophen/caffeine (Fioracet)
- Boldenone
- Methasterone
- Stanolone (androstanolone)
