Masking Requirement for Unvaccinated Healthcare Workers



If you are not vaccinated, wear a mask during direct patient contact to help prevent and reduce the spread of influenza.

Healthcare workers who are not vaccinated against seasonal influenza must wear a surgical mask during direct patient contact when influenza is declared to be widespread by the Director of the Rhode Island Department of Health.

An annual flu vaccine is recommended for everyone age 6 months and older.
