

# HOSPITAL Healthcare Worker Influenza Vaccination Status 2015-16 Influenza Season

This report summarizes **HOSPITAL** healthcare worker (HCW) influenza vaccination status for the 2015–2016 influenza season. Individual **hospital** data, both number and percent, are presented in the next page(s).

During 2015–2016 influenza season, the following healthcare facilities were required to submit their HCW influenza vaccination status data to Rhode Island Department of Health.<sup>1</sup> They included:

## Components of Data Submission

*Type of HCWs:*


- a) Employees
- b) Non-employees: licensed independent practitioners (LIPs)
- c) Non-employees: students, trainees and volunteers (STVs)

*HCW Influenza Vaccination Status:*

- a) Received an influenza vaccination (Vacc.)
- b) Declined due to medical contraindications (Med Exemp.)
- c) Declined for reasons other than medical contraindications (Decl.)
- d) Unknown vaccination status (Unk.)

## Summary of HCW Influenza Vaccination, 2015-16 Season


### Influenza Vaccination Reporting Rate
