## What is Vaccinate Before You Graduate (VBYG)?

- VBYG is a school-located vaccination program that administers eleven (11) important vaccines to Rhode Island middle and high school students.
- Vaccinations are provided to students during the school day at clinics held throughout the year.
- There is no out-of-pocket cost for vaccines administered through the program.
- Vaccinations help reduce school absenteeism and loss of work time for parents.

## Summary of your school's 2021-2022 Vaccinate Before You Graduate participation

Your school was one of 25 to participate in PROVIDENCE

- 4 students participated from your school, out of a total 574 for PROVIDENCE
- 8 vaccines were administered at your school, out of a total 1339 for PROVIDENCE
