**VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF PARAMEDIC LICENSE**

Tanasith Justin Martineau (hereinafter "Respondent") is licensed as a Paramedic pursuant to R. I. Gen. Laws Chapter 23-4.1 and holds license number EMT15639. Respondent has notified the Department of Health, Division of Preparedness, Response, Infectious Disease and Emergency Medical Services, Center for Emergency Medical Services (hereinafter "RIDOH") that he wishes to surrender his license for an indefinite period of time of not less than three years to attend to personal issues.


1. Respondent admits to and hereby agrees to remain under the jurisdiction of RIDOH.

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2. Respondent has read this Voluntary Surrender and understands that it is a proposal and is subject to the final approval of RIDOH. This Voluntary Surrender is not binding on Respondent until signed by RIDOH.
3. Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
  - a. The right to appear personally or by counsel or both before RIDOH;
  - b. The right to produce witnesses and evidence in his behalf at a hearing;

- c. The right to cross examine witnesses;
  - d. The right to have subpoenas issued by RIDOH;
  - e. The right to further procedural steps except for specifically contained herein;
  - f. Any and all rights of appeal of this Voluntary Surrender;
  - g. Any objection to the fact that this Voluntary Surrender may be presented to RIDOH for consideration and review;
  - h. Any objection to the fact that it may be necessary for RIDOH to become acquainted with all evidence pertaining to this matter to adequately review this Voluntary Surrender;
  - i. Any objection to the fact that potential bias against the Respondent may occur because of any presentation of this Voluntary Surrender.
4. This Voluntary Surrender shall become part of the public record, posted on RIDOH's website, and may be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank.
  5. Once approved by RIDOH, this Voluntary Surrender shall remain in full force and effect until further order of RIDOH.
  6. Failure to comply with the terms of this Voluntary Surrender shall subject the Respondent to further disciplinary action.
  7. Respondent shall not seek reinstatement for a minimum of thirty-six (36) months. If Respondent seeks reinstatement of his Paramedic license after thirty-six (36) months, he shall submit documentation evidencing that he is capable and competent to practice as an Paramedic, including documentation from a health care provider indicating a resolution of Respondent's personal issues, before RIDOH considers reinstatement. Respondent agrees not to seek licensure or practice as a Paramedic in any other jurisdiction while this Voluntary Surrender is in effect. Respondent understands that the decision whether to reinstate his license remains solely within RIDOH's discretion and authority.


