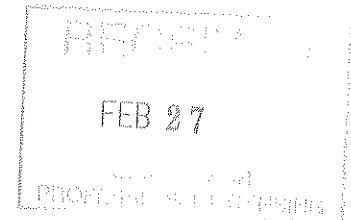

CONSENT ORDER FOR VOLUNTARY SURRENDER

Marie Judelle Jean (“Respondent”) has been licensed as a practical nurse pursuant to R.I Gen. Laws §5-34-11 and the Rules and Regulations for Licensing of Nurses 216-RICR-40-05-3 and holds license number LPN12574 (“License”).

The Respondent recognizes that allegations of professional misconduct have been submitted to the Rhode Island Board of Nursing Registration and Nursing Education (the “Board”) and hereby agrees to voluntarily surrender the Licenses effective immediately.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Respondent holds a license (LPN12574) to practice as a practical nurse in the state of Rhode Island.
2. That on or about February 20 2023, the Respondent entered this voluntary surrender of their license after refusing to provide requested information relative to obtaining their nursing school transcripts.
3. The Respondent voluntarily submits this surrender of License to the Board of Nursing Registration and Nursing Education and states that no promises or representations have been made to her other than those terms and conditions stated herein.
4. The Respondent has read and comprehended the Consent Order and understands that this Consent Order shall be subject to final approval of the Board of Nursing Registration and Nursing Education and is not binding on Respondent until final ratification by the Board of Nursing Registration and Nursing Education.


ACCORDINGLY, AND BASED ON THE FOREGOING

5. The Board of Nursing Registration and Nursing Education and Respondent hereby agree to the following:

- Respondent shall voluntarily surrender the License, reserving the right to petition for reinstatement.
- If Respondent violates any term of this Consent Order, the Board of Nursing Registration and Nursing Education shall have the discretion to impose disciplinary action, including revocation of the License. If the Board of Nursing Registration and Nursing Education imposes further disciplinary action, Respondent shall be given notice of such action and shall have the right to request a hearing within twenty (20) days of such discipline.
