**CONSENT ORDER**

Pursuant to R.I. Gen Laws §23-17.9-1 *et seq.* and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, 216-RICR-40-05-22, the Rhode Island Department of Health and the Nursing Assistant Advisory Board (collectively, "RIDOH") have investigated Complaint No. C19-1697 (the "Complaint") charging Morelia Salcedo, Medication Aide license number MAD01616, ("Respondent") with violations of R.I. Gen Laws §23-17.9-1 *et seq.*

After review and consideration by RIDOH with respect to the allegations of unprofessional conduct of Respondent, the following are and shall constitute

**FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. That Respondent is a Medication Aide licensed to practice in the State of Rhode Island under Medication Aide License Number MAD01616.
2. That at all times relevant hereto, Respondent was employed at Tockwotton on the Waterfront, East Providence, RI.
3. That on or about December 22, 2019, Respondent admits that she administered two (2) combined doses of medication to a patient in her care at one time instead of each dose at separate intervals as ordered by the physician.
4. That the conduct described in paragraph three (3) herein constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to R.I. Gen Laws §23-17.9-1 *et seq.* and the Rules and Regulations promulgated there under.
5. That Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of RIDOH and hereby agrees to remain under the jurisdiction of RIDOH.
6. That Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by Respondent and RIDOH.


7. That Respondent understands the purpose of this Consent Order is solely to resolve the complaint(s) of unprofessional conduct against Respondent alleged in this Consent Order.
8. That Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
  - a) The right to have an administrative hearing on this matter;
  - b) The right to represent oneself or be represented by an attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;
  - c) The right to present testimony, evidence and witnesses on Respondent's behalf;
  - d) The right to cross-examine witnesses presented by RIDOH;
  - e) The right to further procedural steps except for those specifically contained herein;
  - f) The right to take an appeal from the terms of this Consent Order; and
  - g) Any objection that this Consent Order will be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank as well as posted on RIDOH's public website.

**ACCORDINGLY, AND BASED ON THE FOREGOING**

RIDOH and Respondent hereby agree to the following disposition of this Complaint:

1. Respondent is hereby issued the sanction of a Reprimand, starting the day this Consent Order is last executed (the "Effective Date").
2. This Consent Order shall become a permanent part of Respondent's record maintained by RIDOH and a part of a public record of this proceeding.

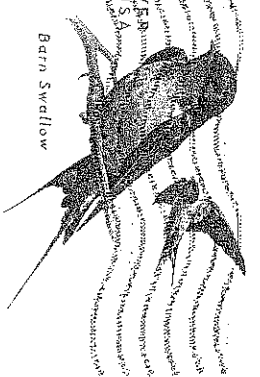
