- 1. Respondent is a Nursing Assistant licensed to practice in Rhode Island under Nursing Assistant License NA 35441.
- 2. On or about May 28, 2019, Respondent entered a plea of nolo contendere in the Providence County Superior Court to one charge of Conspiracy to Commit Medical Assistance Fraud, a felony, and one charge of Medical Assistance Fraud, a felony.
- 3. Conviction of a felony constitutes grounds for revocation of a nursing assistant license pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 23-17.9-8(3).
- 4. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of RIDOH.
- 5. Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by the Respondent and RIDOH.
- 6. That Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
 - a. The right to an administrative hearing on this matter;
 - b. The right to represent himself or be represented by an attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;
 - c. The right to produce testimony, witnesses, and evidence on Respondent's behalf; at a hearing; and
 - d. Any and all rights of appeal.

ACCORDINGLY, AND BASED ON THE FOREGOING

RIDOH and the Respondent hereby agree to the following disposition of this complaint:

- 1. Respondent voluntarily surrenders her Nursing Assistant license.
- 2. This Consent Order shall become a public record.
