CONSENT ORDER

This matter came before the Rhode Island Department of Health's Nursing Assistant Advisory Board on August 7, 2018 upon a request from Gary Menissian (Respondent) for reinstatement of his nursing assistant license. Respondent's nursing assistant license was summarily suspended on August 4, 2011 and expired on June 30, 2013. By a vote of 4 - 0, the Nursing Assistant Advisory Board recommended conditional reinstatement of Respondent's license. Subject to the adoption of the Board's recommendation and this Consent Order by the Director of the Rhode Island Department of Health, the parties have agreed as follows:

- 1. Respondent's application to reinstate his nursing assistant license will not be denied based on the facts alleged in the August 4, 2011 summary suspension or the charges and disposition in the matter of *United States v. Gary Mennisian*, 1:12CR-00044-1.
- 2. Upon reinstatement of his license, Respondent shall serve a two-year period of conditional employment.
- 3. The two-year period of conditional employment shall commence upon employment of Respondent as a nursing assistant. Respondent shall notify the Department of any lapse in employment as a nursing assistant. The two-year period of conditional employment will toll for the duration of any period during which Respondent is not employed as a nursing assistant.
- 4. During the two-year period of conditional employment, Respondent must work under direct supervision at a health care facility or physician's office.
- 5. During the two-year period of conditional employment, Respondent's employer(s) must submit quarterly job performance progress reports regarding Respondent to the Department.

- 6. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Rhode Island Department of Health.
- 7. Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by the Respondent and the Rhode Island Department of Health
- 8. This Consent Order shall become a public record.
