## CONSENT ORDER

Pursuant to R.I. Gen Laws §23-17.9-1 et seq. and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, 216-RICR-40-05-22, the Rhode Island Department of Health and the Nursing Assistant Advisory Board (collectively, "RIDOH") have investigated Complaint No. C22-0903 (the "Complaint") charging Hannah O. Langello, Temporary Nursing Assistant license number NA33522-T, ("Respondent") with violations of R.I. Gen Laws §23-17.9-1 et seq.

After review and consideration by RIDOH with respect to the allegations of unprofessional conduct of Respondent, the following are and shall constitute

## FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- That Respondent is a Temporary Nursing Assistant licensed to practice in the State of Rhode Island under Temporary Nursing Assistant License Number NA33522-T.
- 2. On or about July 19, 2022, it was determined that the Respondent held herself out to be a Nursing Assistant when responding to an on-line inquiry for such services. At that time, she held a Temporary Nursing Assistant license and was unable to represent herself as a Nursing Assistant because she was not fully licensed.
- 3. That the conduct described in paragraph two (2) herein constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to R.I. Gen Laws §23-17.9-1 et seq. and the Rules and Regulations promulgated there under.
- 4. That Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of RIDOH and hereby agrees to remain under the jurisdiction of RIDOH.



- 5. That Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by Respondent and RIDOH.
- 6. That Respondent understands the purpose of this Consent Order is solely to resolve the Complaint.
- 7. That Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:

- a) The right to have an administrative hearing on this matter;
- b) The right to represent oneself or be represented by an attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;
- c) The right to present testimony, evidence and witnesses on Respondent's behalf;
- d) The right to cross-examine witnesses presented by RIDOH;
- e) The right to further procedural steps except for those specifically contained herein;
- f) The right to take an appeal from the terms of this Consent Order; and
- g) Any objection that this Consent Order will be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank as well as posted on RIDOH's public website.

## ACCORDINGLY, AND BASED ON THE FOREGOING

RIDOH and Respondent hereby agree to the following disposition of this Complaint:

- 9. Respondent is hereby issued the sanction of a Reprimand, starting the day this Consent Order is last executed.
- 10. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an agreement between Respondent and RIDOH.
- 11. This Consent Order shall become a permanent part of Respondent's record maintained by RIDOH and a part of a public record of this proceeding.
