CONSENT ORDER

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 23-17.9-1 et seq. and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, the Rhode Island Department of Health (hereinafter "RIDOH"), and the Nursing Assistant Advisory Board (hereinafter "Board") have investigated a complaint charging JENAY AMOS, NA50937 (hereinafter "Respondent"), with conduct subject to disciplinary proceedings pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 23-17.9-8. After review and consideration by RIDOH and the Board with respect to the Respondent's conduct, the following are and shall constitute

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Respondent is a Nursing Assistant licensed to practice in Rhode Island under Nursing Assistant License NA50937.
- 2. At all times relevant hereto, Respondent was employed by Cherry Hill Manor Nursing and Rehabilitation Center ("Cherry Hill").
- 3. On or about February 8, 2018, Cherry Hill resident, "KI", reported to the Johnston Police Department that a substantial amount of unauthorized withdrawals had been made from his checking account. Separate investigation conducted by RI State Police led to the arrest of a relative of the Respondent, who was found to be in the possession of a check belonging to Cherry Hill resident, "KI". On or about May 10, 2018, and thereafter, Respondent has admitted to taking the check belonging to Cherry Hill resident, "KI".
- 4. That the conduct described in paragraph three of this Consent Order constitutes conduct subject to disciplinary proceedings pursuant to R. I. Gen. Laws §23-17.9-8 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder.

- 5. That the Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of RIDOH.
- 6. Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by the Respondent and RIDOH.
- 7. That Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
 - a. The right to an administrative hearing on this matter;
 - b. The right to represent himself or be represented by an attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;
 - c. The right to produce testimony, witnesses, and evidence on Respondent's behalf; at a hearing; and
 - d. Any and all rights of appeal.

ACCORDINGLY, AND BASED ON THE FOREGOING

RIDOH and the Respondent hereby agree to the following disposition of this complaint:

- 1. Respondent is hereby issued the sanction of a six (6) month Suspension of her Nursing Assistant license, NA50937.
- 2. Respondent must complete Continuing Education courses in Legal Rights, Patient's Rights, and Ethics, from a provider approved by the Board.
- 3. Respondent must provide the Board proof of completion of required Continuing Education courses before she will be allowed to renew her license.
- 4. This Consent Order shall become a public record.
