## **CONSENT ORDER**

Pursuant to R.I. Gen Laws §23-17.9-1 et seq. and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, 216-RICR-40-05-22, the Rhode Island Department of Health ("RIDOH") has investigated Complaint No. C23-0770H (the "Complaint") charging JULIA JIMENEZ, NA 35451-T, ("Respondent") with violations of R.I. Gen Laws §23-17.9-1 et seq.

After review and consideration by RIDOH with respect to the allegations of unprofessional conduct of Respondent, the following are and shall constitute,

## FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. That Respondent was licensed by the State of Rhode Island as a temporary nursing assistant on March 10, 2023, under nursing assistant license NA 35451-T.
- 2. Respondent's temporary nursing assistant license expired on July 10, 2023.
- 3. Respondent worked as a nursing assistant on behalf of Caregivers RI before her temporary license was issued and after her temporary license expired.
- 4. That the conduct described in paragraph three (3) herein constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to R.I. Gen Laws §23-17.9-1 et seq. and the Rules and Regulations promulgated there under.
- 5. That Respondent acknowledges that she is not licensed as a nursing assistant in Rhode Island and that she must immediately stop working as a nursing assistant in Rhode Island, and that she may not work as a nursing assistant in Rhode Island unless and until she holds a valid license issued by the State of Rhode Island.
- 6. That Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of RIDOH and hereby agrees to remain under the jurisdiction of RIDOH.
- 7. That Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by Respondent and RIDOH.

- 8. That Respondent understands the purpose of this Consent Order is solely to resolve the Complaint.
- 9. That Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
  - a) The right to have an administrative hearing on this matter;
  - b) The right to represent oneself or be represented by an attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;
  - c) The right to present testimony, evidence and witnesses on Respondent's behalf:
  - d) The right to cross-examine witnesses presented by RIDOH;
  - e) The right to further procedural steps except for those specifically contained herein;
  - f) The right to take an appeal from the terms of this Consent Order; and
  - g) Any objection that this Consent Order will (i) be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank, (ii) become a permanent part of Respondent's record maintained by RIDOH and a part of the public record of this proceeding, or (iii) be posted on RIDOH's public website.

## ACCORDINGLY, AND BASED ON THE FOREGOING

RIDOH and Respondent	hereby agree	to the follo	wing dispos	ition of this	Complaint:
RIDOH and Respondent acKnowle	dges that she	engaged in	i un profess	nonal condi	uct.

- 9. Respondent is hereby issued the sanction of a Reprimand, starting the day this Consent Order is last executed.
- 10. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an agreement between Respondent and RIDOH.
