CONSENT ORDER

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 23-17.9-1 *et seq.* and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, the Rhode Island Department of Health (RIDOH) has investigated a complaint charging LINDSAY COLE (Respondent), with conduct subject to disciplinary proceedings pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 23-17.9-8. After review and consideration by RIDOH with respect to the Respondent's conduct, the following are and shall constitute

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about December 14 2018, Respondent was licensed as a temporary nursing assistant, License NA28304-T.
2. On or about December 14, 2018, while employed as a nursing assistant at Coventry Skilled Nursing, Respondent failed to complete her scheduled shift.
3. Respondent is currently licensed as a nursing assistant, License NA53291.
4. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of RIDOH.
5. Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by the Respondent and RIDOH.
6. Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
 - a. The right to an administrative hearing on this matter;
 - b. The right to represent herself or be represented by an attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;

- c. The right to produce testimony, witnesses, and evidence on Respondent's behalf at said hearing; and
- d. Any and all rights of appeal.


ACCORDINGLY AND BASED UPON THE FOREGOING
