FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On or about December 14 2018, Respondent was licensed as a temporary nursing assistant, License NA28304-T.
- 2. On or about December 14, 2018, while employed as a nursing assistant at Coventry Skilled Nursing, Respondent failed to complete her scheduled shift.
- 3. Respondent is currently licensed as a nursing assistant, License NA53291.
- 4. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of RIDOH.
- 5. Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by the Respondent and RIDOH.
- 6. Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
 - a. The right to an administrative hearing on this matter;
 - b. The right to represent herself or be represented by an attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;

- c. The right to produce testimony, witnesses, and evidence on Respondent's behalf at said hearing; and
- d. Any and all rights of appeal.

ACCORDINGLY, AND BASED UPON THE FOREGOING

RIDOH and the Respondent hereby agree as follows:

1. Respondent is hereby issued the sanction of a reprimand.
