CONSENT ORDER

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is a Nursing Assistant licensed to practice in Rhode Island under Nursing Assistant License NA 50361.
- 2. On or about December 18, 2018, Respondent entered a plea of nolo contendre in the Providence County Superior Court to two counts of giving a false document to an agent, employee, or public official in the case captioned P2-2018-0100(F), *State of Rhode Island v. Martine Silva*.
- 3. The conduct described in paragraph 2 constitutes conduct subject to disciplinary proceedings pursuant to R. I. Gen. Laws §23-17.9-8(3) and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder.
- 4. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of RIDOH.
- 5. Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by the Respondent and RIDOH.
- 6. Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
 - a. The right to an administrative hearing on this matter;
 - b. The right to represent herself or be represented by an attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;

- c. The right to produce testimony, witnesses, and evidence on Respondent's behalf at said hearing; and
- d. Any and all rights of appeal.

ACCORDINGLY, AND BASED UPON THE FOREGOING

RIDOH and the Respondent hereby agree as follows:

Respondent's nursing assistant license is suspended for a period of ONE YEAR from the date of ratification of this Consent Order

This Consent Order shall become a public record.
