CONSENT ORDER

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 23-17.9-1 et seq. and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, the Rhode Island Department of Health (hereinafter "RIDOH"), and the Nursing Assistant Advisory Board (hereinafter "Board") have investigated a complaint charging MICHELLE CORSI, NA12435 (hereinafter "Respondent"), with conduct subject to disciplinary proceedings pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 23-17.9-8. After review and consideration by RIDOH and the Board with respect to the Respondent's conduct, the following are and shall constitute

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is a Nursing Assistant licensed to practice in Rhode Island under Nursing Assistant License NA12435.
- 2. At all times relevant hereto, Respondent was self-employed.
- 3. On or about September 18, 2018, it was discovered that Respondent was advertising the offering of Nursing Assistant services by means of a "business" she had attempted to form for such purpose. The services being offered fall outside the scope of practice of a licensed Nursing Assistant. Respondent admits that she has performed services which fall outside of her scope of practice while employed as a licensed Nursing Assistant.
- 4. That the conduct described in paragraph three of this Consent Order constitutes conduct subject to disciplinary proceedings pursuant to R. I. Gen. Laws §23-17.9-8 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder.
- 5. That the Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of RIDOH.

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- 6. Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by the Respondent and RIDOH.
- 7. That Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:

a. The right to an administrative hearing on this matter;

b. The right to represent himself or be represented by an attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;

c. The right to produce testimony, witnesses, and evidence on Respondent's behalf; at a hearing; and

d. Any and all rights of appeal.

ACCORDINGLY, AND BASED ON THE FOREGOING

RIDOH and the Respondent hereby agree to the following disposition of this complaint:

1. Respondent is hereby issued the sanction of a two (2) year Suspension of her Nursing Assistant license, NA12435, with retraining.

2. This Consent Order shall become a public record.
