CONSENT ORDER

Pursuant to R.I. Gen Laws §23-17.9-1 et seq. and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, 216-RICR-40-05-22, the Rhode Island Department of Health ("RIDOH") has investigated Complaint No. C24-0891 (the "Complaint") charging The Aquidneck Island Adult Learning Center ("Respondent") with violations of R.I. Gen. Laws and Department of Health Regulations.

After review and consideration by RIDOH with respect to the allegations of unprofessional conduct of Respondent, the following are and shall constitute

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. That Respondent was licensed by RIDOH as a nursing assistant training program under NATP License Number 00108 from January 15, 2015 until January 15, 2023 when its license expired.
- 2. Subsequent to January 15, 2023, Respondent continued to operate as a nursing assistant training program despite the fact that its license had expired,
- 3. On or about October 15, 2024, Respondent was relicensed and issued NATP License Number 00171.
- 4. That the conduct described in paragraph two (2) herein constitutes a violation 216-RICR-40-05-22.7.1(A), promulgated pursuant to R.I. Gen Laws § 23-17.9-3.
- 5. That Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of RIDOH and hereby agrees to remain under the jurisdiction of RIDOH.
- 6. That Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by Respondent and RIDOH.

- 7. That Respondent understands the purpose of this Consent Order is solely to resolve the Complaint.
- 8. That Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
 - a) The right to have an administrative hearing on this matter;
 - b) The right to represent oneself or be represented by an attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;
 - c) The right to present testimony, evidence and witnesses on Respondent's behalf:
 - d) The right to cross-examine witnesses presented by RIDOH;
 - e) The right to further procedural steps except for those specifically contained herein:
 - f) The right to take an appeal from the terms of this Consent Order; and
 - g) Any objection that this Consent Order will (i) be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank, (ii) become a permanent part of Respondent's record maintained by RIDOH and a part of the public record of this proceeding, or (iii) be posted on RIDOH's public website.

ACCORDINGLY AND BASED ON THE FOREGOING

RIDOH and Respondent hereby agree to the following disposition of this Complaint:

- 9. Respondent agrees to a finding that it was operating as a nursing assistant training program without a license.
- 10. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an agreement between Respondent and RIDOH.
