CONSENT ORDER

Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-34-25, a complaint was filed with the Board for Nurse

Registration and Nursing Education (hereinafter referred to as "Board"), charging Phillip Olivier, RN31138 (hereinafter referred to as "Respondent") with a violation of one or more provisions of

R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-34-24.

After due consideration by the Committee of the Board, the following constitutes the

Findings of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent:

1. Respondent is a registered nurse licensed to practice in the State of Rhode Island.

2. That at all pertinent times, Respondent was employed by St. Josephs Hospital Fatima, 200 High Service Avenue, North Providence, RI 02904.

3. That on or about 9/3/2013, Respondent Nurse Olivier allegedly failed to follow the hospital's "Constant Observation" policy for a patient who arrived at the ED after a suicide attempt and revealed she wanted to commit suicide.

4. That the conduct described in paragraph three (3) herein constitutes unprofessional

conduct pursuant to § 5-34-24 and the Rules and Regulations for the Licensing of

Nurses.

The parties agree as follows:

This Consent Order is not binding on Respondent until final ratification by the Board.

(a) Respondent is a registered nurse licensed and doing business under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Rhode Island, license number, RN31138.

(b) Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Board and hereby agrees to

remain under the jurisdiction of the Board;

(c) Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that it is a proposal

of the Board and is subject to the final approval by the Board. This Consent Order is not binding on Respondent until final ratification by the Board.

(d) Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:

(1) The right to appear personally or by counsel or both before the Board;

(2) The right to produce witnesses and evidence on Respondent's behalf at a

hearing;

(3) The right to cross-examine witnesses;

(4) The right to have subpoenas issued by the Board;

(5) The right to further procedural steps except for those specifically contained

herein;

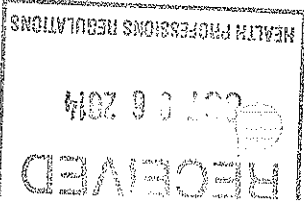
(6) Any and all rights of appeal of this Consent Order;

(7) Any objection to the fact that this Consent Order will be presented to the Board for consideration and review;

(8) Any objection to the fact that it will be necessary for the Board to become

acquainted with all evidence pertaining to this matter in order to review adequately

this Consent Order;



(9) Any objection to the fact that potential bias against the Respondent may occur:

a result of the presentation of this Consent Order. The signing of this Consent Ord

is for settlement purposes only.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby enters the following:

1. This Consent Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding once it is accepted by all parties and accepted by the Board.

2. Acceptance by the Respondent and approval by the Board of this Consent Order constitutes an admission of the facts contained herein.

3. Failure to comply with the Consent Order, once signed and accepted, shall subject the Respondent to further disciplinary action.

4. Respondent agrees to a **Reprimand** on Respondent's RN31138 license and to complete CEU's from [anursece.healthstream.com](http://anursece.healthstream.com) for 3 courses: **Scope and Standards of Nursing Practice, Psychiatric Emergencies in Med-Surg Patients Are You Prepared, and Psychiatric/Mental Health Nursing review and Resource Manual 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition**

5. That should Respondent violate the terms of this Consent Order, Respondent shall be subject to further disciplinary actions.
