## Relief for Employees

If your employment has been impacted by COVID-19, there are resources for you.  
**Please do not go into work if you are sick.**

### Paid Sick Leave

- Paid Sick Leave through the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) — determine your eligibility at: <https://www.dol.gov/agencies/whd/ffcra/benefits-eligibility-webtool>
- Paid Sick Leave through the Rhode Island Healthy and Safe Families and Workplaces Act — find more information at <https://dlt.ri.gov/documents/pdf/ls/HSFWfactsheet.pdf>

### Unemployment and disability insurance

- If you have been laid off from your position due to COVID-19, you may be eligible for unemployment insurance. Please visit [dlt.ri.gov/covid19](https://dlt.ri.gov/covid19).
- If you are a gig economy worker, contract worker, small business owner, worker for hire, self-employed, or other worker ineligible for regular unemployment insurance benefits, you can apply for emergency COVID unemployment insurance with DLT at [covidemergencyuibenefits.dlt.ri.gov](https://covidemergencyuibenefits.dlt.ri.gov).
- If your place of employment is open, but you are unable to work because of COVID-19, you may be eligible for benefits. Please visit [dlt.ri.gov/covid19](https://dlt.ri.gov/covid19).
