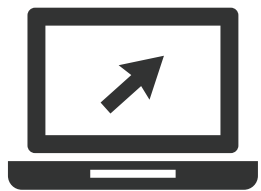


Positive for COVID-19?

1 Go to portal.ri.gov/results to fill out the Contact Tracing Survey.



- It's an easy way for you to report your contacts to the Rhode Island Department of Health without having to talk to a person on the telephone.
- You will also be given information on isolation supports and treatment options.

2 Seek treatment if you're eligible.



- If you have an existing **condition** that makes it more likely for you to get very sick from COVID-19, and have had mild to moderate symptoms in the last 10 days, call your healthcare provider and ask about treatment. Learn more at covid.ri.gov/treatment.
