Everyone 6 months and older



RSV Immunization to Protect Babies Vaccine

Pregnant parents during weeks 32-36 of pregnancy during RSV season

OR

Monoclonal Antibodies
Babies entering or born
during the RSV season



RSV Vaccine for Older Adults

(currently, older adults only need to get the RSV vaccine once; not annually) People ages 60 and over at high risk of severe RSV

AND

Everyone ages 75 and older
