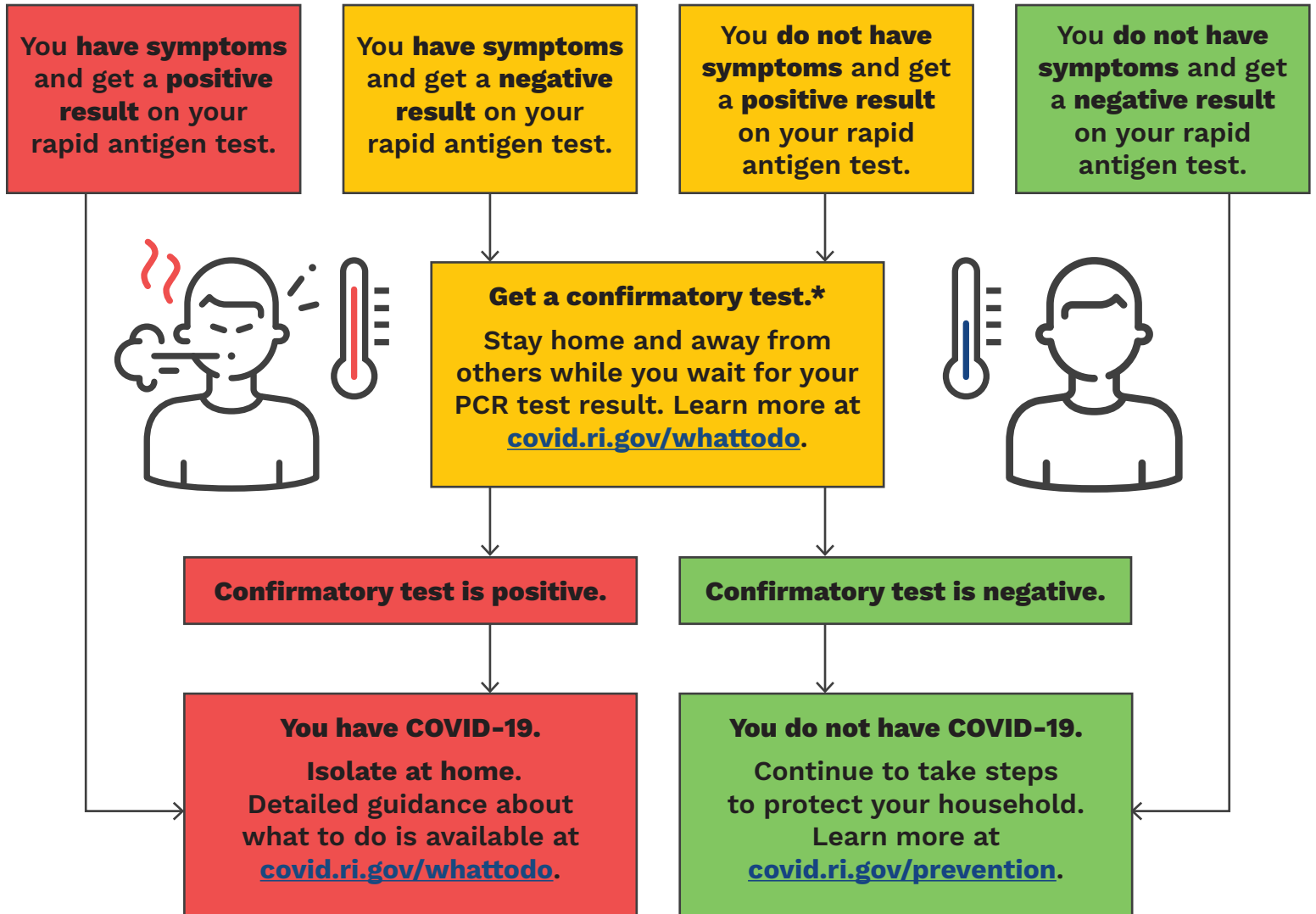


COVID-19 Confirmatory Testing Protocol

The Rhode Island Department of Health (RIDOH) recommends confirmatory testing if you do not have [symptoms](#) of COVID-19 and get a positive result on a rapid antigen test, or if you have [symptoms](#) and get a negative result on a rapid antigen test.



* Your confirmatory test must be a lab-processed nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT) or polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test. You cannot use a rapid NAAT or PCR test or an at-home NAAT or PCR test to confirm your rapid antigen test result.
