# If You Have COVID-19 Symptoms or are Exposed to Someone with COVID-19:

- Staff and children should <u>stay home when sick</u> and <u>get tested</u> when they have <u>symptoms of COVID-19</u>.
- Encourage anyone <u>exposed</u> to someone who has COVID-19 to watch for symptoms, get tested after 5 full days, and wear a <u>well-fitting mask</u> for 10 days.

### **Everyday Steps to Prevent COVID-19**

- How to Protect Yourself and Others [English] [Español]

- Promote good hygiene, like good handwashing, and covering coughs and sneezes
- Regularly <u>clean and disinfect</u> surfaces to prevent the spread of germs
- Follow data from the CDC, like how many people are admitted to local hospitals because of COVID-19, to help you decide what prevention measures to use [English] [Español]
- Child care programs should consider <u>universal masking</u> when <u>COVID-19 Hospital Admission Levels</u> are high
- Schools should consider <u>screening testing</u> when <u>COVID-19 Hospital Admission Levels</u> are medium or high

## **TREAT**

**Isolation:** If positive for COVID-19, <u>isolate at home</u> for at least 5 full days and wear a mask around other people through day 10.
