Individuals (age 9-18) need 4 vaccines to protect against meningococcal disease, some cancers, whooping cough, and other serious diseases, according to national guidelines.

- HPV dose 1
- HPV dose 2 (6-12 months after dose 1)

- HPV doses 1 and 2 (if not given at ages 9-10)
- MenACWY dose 1
- Tdap (one dose)

16

- MenACWY dose 2
- MenB dose 1
- MenB dose 2 (1-2 months after dose 1)

YEARLY

- Flu Vaccine (every year, every age, for adolescents)
